GATHERING RATE: The rates named herein are for trunk line transportation only and no gathering service will be performed under this tariff.

NOTE: The following exceptions to Sunoco Pipeline L.P.'s FERC No. 169.0.0, Rules and Regulations, only apply to movements from Ellis Junction to Wynnewood.

- A. Exception to Item 40, F.E.R.C. No 169.0.0, Measurement, Testing, Volume Correction and Deductions – Crude Petroleum quantities transported may be adjusted to allow for inherent losses, including but not limited to shrinkage, evaporation, interface losses and normal "over and short" losses. Adjustments will be made on the basis of total quantities transported for each crude segregation and shall be based on actual historical experience. No other assessment will be charged to cover transportation allowance.
- B. Exception to Item 55, F.E.R.C. No 169.0.0, Application of Rates and Charges – Transportation charges will be collected on the basis of net quantities of Petroleum received.
